The Invasion of Ukraine: Implications for the SDGs in Russia

Like all UN member states, Russia declared its commitment to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in 2015. On February 24, 2022, Russia launched a full-scale invasion of the territory of a sovereign state, Ukraine, accompanied by the shelling of peaceful cities. The Russian state's military aggression and repressive actions against its population contradict the 2030 Agenda on Sustainable Development, although officials continue to declare their commitment to achieving the SDGs.

The civil society Coalition for Sustainable Development of Russia (CSDR) has conducted an analysis of the implementation of the SDGs in Russia since February 2022, since the situation in the country changed dramatically due to the outbreak of aggression against Ukraine. In this report, CSDR has reviewed all the SDGs describing what has changed in the implementation of each of the SDGs since February 24, 2022, and how these changes have affected Russia's international cooperation.

The presentation of the report will take place on March 1st, 2023 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm at the House of Democracy and Human Rights (Haus der Demokratie und Menschenrechte) and will provide a platform for Russian civil society and academia to present outcomes of the report and discuss the complexity of the consequences of the war for Russia itself.
